DISCOVERY ORDER OF SEPTEMBER 19, 2023

Upon reading and filing Respondent, PayPal's Motion to Compel Discovery Responses Against Claimant, Loot, Inc., Claimant's Opposition to PayPal's Motion to Compel Discovery Responses, the Arbitrator being advised that the parties have resolved disputes involving interrogatories numbers 1, 3 and 16, and request for production (presumably 2) and 5, and the Arbitrator being otherwise fully advised in the premises;

NOW, THEREFORE;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Claimant, Loot, Inc., is ordered to supplement interrogatory #18 and #21 within 14 days from the date of this Order;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent, PayPal's request for production #7, be, and hereby is denied as overbroad given the facts and issues as disclosed to date in this matter;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Motion's request for production #8 be, and hereby is granted, but only to the extent that the communications between Loot and Player Up users involved or related to PayPal, its goods and/or services.
